



CBBA GENERAL MEETING MINUTES



For Subscribing Groups, type in "Cherokee Bluff Band" (which will probably appear as a choice) and fill out the rest of the form. We will get a notification and you will receive and email with additional information. Please see the band directors for more information.

CUT TIME is an online database that CBBA uses to manage and maintain the student accounts, inventory, sign up volunteers and contact information. Student account statements can be viewed at any time by all band families through CUT TIME.

2022 Cherokee Bluff Band Fees

- If your child owns their own instrument: \$450
- If your child plays percussion or uses a school owned instrument: \$550
- If your child is in Guard Fee: \$650
- If your child is a non-marching member: \$50 (\$100 total if your child plays percussion or uses a school owned instrument)

Schedule:

- Deposit due May 12, 2022 of \$200 (\$300 for Guard, Percussion and School Owned Instruments)
- Color Guard Only Uniform Fee ***\$100 June 28 (Guard Camp)
- Band Camp due July 15th (\$250)

BREAKFAST:

Parents, please make sure your child has plenty of breakfast every morning during the next two weeks.

We are providing breakfast daily (7:35am-7:50am). It is **IMPERATIVE** that students arrive to Band Camp already <u>hydrated</u> and <u>nourished</u>.

Breakfast IS the most important meal of the day!

Students must bring their water coolers full of ice everyday!

I highly recommend that students bring snacks to have during the day at various breaks.

Please avoid sending SODA and other sugar snacks. Please consider Gatorades and healthy snacks.

DINNER:

We will be serving dinner during the 2nd week of Band Camp. I am so very thankful to Brandi Selman for organizing these meals.

We will be posting the menu for Dinner meals soon.

Parents are welcomed to drop off meals during Band Camp, but <u>students are NOT allowed to leave campus at anytime</u>.

BAND CAMP 2022

What to Bring DAILY:

- Light colored, loose fitting clothing (NO JEANS or other long pants)
- Comfortable shoes (No flip flops or sandals)
- Second pair of shoes...I will allow students to wear flip flops or sandals during Indoor Rehearsals.
- *Sun screen (even during the morning!)
- Insect Repellent
- Cooling Towel
- Hat or Visor AND Sunglasses
- Small gym sack/bag
- BAND WATER JUG WATER is a must. NO SODA.
- Music Binder
- Instruments & Performance Equipment (Guard)

Everyone picks up trash and empty trash cans. Student leaders ensure all of our areas are squared away before leaving.

11:45pm	Music Block (Indoors) Have <u>ALL</u> music that you have already received plus new that you will get daily.
3:00pm	Combined Music Rehearsal (Indoors - Cafeteria)
4:00pm	Band Dismissed

All students must be picked up no more than 15 minutes after dismissal.

Student Health & Safety:

Our students' health and safety is our number one priority throughout all camp rehearsals. It is going to be VERY HOT...and we must take precautions to deal with the Georgia Summer Heat.

To that end, we only go outdoors in the early mornings (8:00am-11:00am) and evening (6:30pm-8:00pm).

We will give frequent hydration breaks (written into the schedule for every 30-45 minutes), and rehearsal will rotate from outdoors to indoors throughout the day.

We will follow the Hall Co. Schools guidelines on practicing in extreme heat found here: https://www.hallco.org/web/practicing-in-extreme-heat-guidelines/.

Parent volunteers will be present as an extra set of eyes to ensure that all students are watched and cared.
