Leaders are people who can offer something new and different to the organization. This application process is structured to gain insights into yourself as a person, so please be honest and thorough. You need to open up and show the person what you truly are or what you aspire to be. Whether you are chosen to participate in the position you apply for is not the penultimate point. Dig deep inside, answer the questions, and complete the service project with the intent of learning something new. Please do not fill out this application unless you are prepared to participate in the leadership training process.

**Complete the following projects:**

4. Complete a service project for the band. The scope and duration of the project are at your discretion. You may choose something you think needs to be done, or you may ask Mr. Cantrell for a project. If you have any questions about the validity of your chosen project, please speak with Mr. Cantrell prior to starting it.
5. Open forum: this is where you have the opportunity to show your creative side. You may do anything that you deem appropriate to convince us that you are able to "think outside the box" and address issues in a different manner. This is the portion of the application where you should expect to learn the most about yourself as an individual. Therefore, take a risk here. Once again, this should be fun for you and the band.

You must be willing to make that sacrifice so that others around you may succeed.
