- President's Report:

- Concessions:

 - Saturday, October 28th will be the middle school honor band prep day from 8:30-12:30. Honor band auditions will be December 2, 2023 in the morning.
 - o January 9, 2024 will be our next general band parent meeting.
 - o The 6th grade band is playing really well.
 - o Middle school band is prepping for the holiday concert.
 - o A mentorship program is being set up for high school students to mentor middle school students. Julia Caron is leading this program.
- Mr. Cantrell
 - o Fall Concert is for high school only and will be Thursday, October 26, 2023 in the high school small gym. Details are in "Cut Time." Halloween costumes are acceptable. Students received a brochure that they were supposed to give parents to sign with details.
 - o Thursday, December 14, 2023 will be the holiday concert for High School and Middle School students.
 - For the first time the marching band will participate in two Christmas parades.
 The first is the Flowery Branch Parade Saturday, November 18th. The second will be the Gainesville parade Sunday, December 2nd. For both parades, students will meet at the school and be bussed to the locations.
 - The band trip has been announced and is on "Cut Time" including the itinerary.
 The trip will be April 19-20 to Carowinds 8th grade band and high school band.
 The cost is \$385 and might be less depending on gas prices at the time of the

trip. The first deposit of \$150 is due December 1, 2023. The second payment is due January 1, 2024 at \$126 and the last payment is due February 15, 2024 at \$99 or less. We will have a trip meeting November 7th, 2023.
